

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORA SPRINGS, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SPEED REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Nora Springs, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 63.04 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Nora Springs, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

63.04 SPECIAL SPEED RESTRICTIONS. In accordance with requirements of the Iowa State Department of Transportation, or whatever the Council shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any speed limit listed in Section 63.02 is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of the City street system, the Council shall determine and adopt by ordinance such higher or lower speed limit as it deems reasonable and safe at such location. The following special speed zones have been established:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.290)

1. Special 25 MPH Speed Zones. A speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour is unlawful on any of the following designated streets or parts thereof.
 - A. On North Iowa Avenue from Congress Street to Spring Drive.
 - B. On Spring Drive when traveling east from North Iowa Avenue until the curve, then increasing to 45 MPH.
 - C. On Rock Grove Drive within the City limits.
 - D. On River Road when traveling north on gravel until the curve which is posted 10 MPH.
 - E. On East Congress Street from the west intersection of Bison Drive and East Congress Street in a westerly direction to approximately 450 foot west of the bridge on West Congress Street.
2. Special 30 MPH Speed Zone. A speed in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour is unlawful on any of the following designated streets or parts thereof.
 - A. On West Congress Street from the intersection of North Boulder Avenue west to approximately 450 feet east of North Hooker Avenue.
3. Special 35 MPH Speed Zones. A speed in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per

hour is unlawful on any of the following designated streets or parts thereof.

A. On 9th Street SW within City limits.

B. On West Congress Avenue eastbound, approximately 450 feet west of the Public Works drive.

C. On South Hooker Avenue from 1st Street SW to the south City limits.

4. Special 45 MPH Speed Zones. A speed in excess of forty-five miles per hour is unlawful on any of the following designated streets or parts thereof.

A. On North Iowa Avenue from Spring Drive to north City limits.

B. On West Congress Street from 450 feet west of the Public Works Drive to approximately 225 feet west of Zinnia Avenue centerline.

C. On East Congress Street from the west intersection of Bison Drive and East Congress; east to the City limits.

D. On B-30 eastbound, beginning approximately 225 feet west of Zinnia Avenue centerline.

5. Special 55 MPH Speed Zone. A speed in excess of fifty-five MPH, in the westbound lane approximately 225 feet west of the Zinnia Avenue centerline.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
